**Dear President Ortiz:**

This is to acknowledge receipt of Transco's letter/reply dated 13 December 2005 to our letter-query dated 9 December 2005 informing us that the *"names of projects and subtransmission assets divested by Transco are posted and can be downloaded from [www.transco.ph](http://www.transco.ph) website."*

Per your advisory, we downloaded the data we requested from Transco's website but was disappointed to find out that the same did not provide the answers to our earlier query which were as follows:

1. Name and description of the project, amount/cost, location, winning bidder and whether the cost is financed by internal cash or through loans; and
2. Name of subtransmission asset sold, amount/cost, name of buyer and the terms of the payment.

Although the Transco website did list the names, description and location of the upgrading projects, still it did not answer our earlier query as the information is inadequate. Cases in point:

1. The "Supply and Delivery Projects on Stream" did not state the cost/amount of each project mentioned and the winning bidders of every project are not named.

2. The "Construction and Supply Projects on Stream" did not state the cost/amount of every project mentioned and not all names of the winning bidders were stated in the information.
3. The "On-Going Turnkey Projects" did not also state the amount/cost of all the projects, some projects did not state the financing source and the name of the winning bidders were not mentioned for those projects that were already bid out.

As to the subtransmission assets to be sold, the Transco website merely mention the names of the subtransmission assets, voltage, classification, type, number of poles, length, customers connected and inventory status. These were information that we were not asking in our earlier letter.

In view of this, we are reiterating our earlier request in our letter dated 9 December 2005. Again, in the spirit of public service and transparency we hope this request will be acted with dispatch by your office.
