Dear Dr. Ortiz:

Warm greetings!

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 28 August 2006 inviting me as one of the resource speakers to the consultation on Transco's 2006 Transmission Development Plan (TDP) scheduled on September 13 (Davao City), September 19 (Quezon City) and September 21 (Cebu).

I am deeply honored by your invitation but I deeply regret that I can not accept the invitation as I have prior commitments that are in conflict with the scheduled public consultations.

Moreover, as we have pointed out in our earlier letters, TDP consultations for electricity end-users (commercial, industrial and residential customers) should be separate from that of the utilities. The rationale for this is that electricity end-users have different interests and level of understanding of the issues compared with power utilities. This suggestion is based on our years of active participation and involvement in the deliberations of various issues in the power industry through the holding of fora in partnership with different government and private organizations.

We hope Transco will consider coming up with TDP consultations as suggested above. And should Transco feel that we can be of help in designing the Consultation program, please feel free to advise us.

Finally, may we reiterate our requests for data/information as stated in our letters dated 9 June 2006 (addressed to VP Dominador Geonzon) and 7 June 2006 (addressed to Edgardo Orenca). We need these data for our consumer education campaigns.
