Dear ERC Commissioners,

Greetings!

This refers to the application of the Don Orestes Romualdez Electric Cooperative, Inc. (DORELCO) for the approval of a reduction in rates and loan condonation in compliance with Section 60 of R.A. 9136 and Executive Order No. 119, with prayer for provisional authority under ERC Case No. 2003-365 which was filed on 10 July 2003 with the Commission.

Section 60 of the EPIRA effectively condoned all the financial obligations of the electric cooperatives (DORELCO included) with NEA and other government agencies.

On 05 August 2003, this Honorable Commission issued an Order granting DORELCO a provisional authority for a rate reduction to reflect the amount of loan (financial obligation) condoned in the amount of **P114,319634.73** or equivalent to P0.2074/kWh for all classes of customers.

The Commission issued its final Decision on 20 February 2005 approving the final rate reduction for each class of customers, as follows:

Also, may we be updated as to when was this implemented, how much of the **P114,319634.73** loan condoned has been enjoyed by DORELCO customers and its remaining balance to date?
