Greetings!

One of the things consumers want to be assured of is that its electric cooperative is operating within certain limitations allowed either by its own rules or by the rules set by the National Electrification Administration (NEA), the supervising and controlling government agency for electric cooperatives under them and the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) which approves the rates it charges to its captive customers.

We refer specifically to the monthly expenses of LEYECO II on fuel/gasoline (premium gas or diesel) for all its cooperative vehicles.

In this regard, may we be furnished copy of the detailed list of all Leyeco II-owned vehicles with their corresponding model and year of acquisition and cost and to whom are each of this vehicle officially assigned to?

Further, may we also be furnished of the amount or quantity of gas allowed on a per liter basis for each vehicle?
